Definite and Indefinite Nouns

Indefinite (نَكِرَة): Any noun that accepts 'ال' (to be added to it) and it makes the noun definite (unlike 'الحَسَــن' for instance, in which 'حَسَــن' is already definite without 'ال'); or any noun that can be replaced by such a noun that accepts 'ال') (such as 'صاحب' and 'صاحب' can accept 'ال').

Definite Nouns (any noun that is not indefinite):

- Pronouns; such as 'هُم'
- Demonstrative nouns; such as 'ذی'

 - Nouns with 'الغُلام'; such as
 - Relative pronouns; such as 'الذى'
 - Added to one of the definite nouns; such as 'ابنی'
