'نا' is common among the three states of *i'rab*; such as in 'أَعْرِفْ بِنَا فَإِنَّا نلنا المنح'.

'ى' is also common among the three states of *i'rab*; such as in 'أَضْرِبِىْ', 'أَكْرَمَنِىْ' and 'مَرِّبِىْ'; although it is for the second person in the first.

'هم' is also common among the three states of *i'rab*; such as in 'أَكْرَمْتُهُمْ', 'هُم قَائِمُونَ' and 'لَهُمْ'; although it is detached in the first.

The third and second person; such as in 'قاما' and 'اعلمما'

Examples:

Third person → 'الهندات قُمنَ', 'الزيدون قاموا', 'الزيدان قاما'
Second person → 'اعلمما، اعلموا، اعلمن'
