Types of Proper Noun

Sometimes a genus noun resembles the proper noun verbally but in fact, it is still indefinite in the meaning; such as 'ثعالة' (fox).

و وضعوا لبعض الاجناس علم
كعلم الأشخاص لفظاً و هو عمّ

من ذاك: أم عريط للعقرب
و هكذا ثعالة للثعلب
و مثله برة للمبرة
كذا فجار علم للفجرة

Types of Proper Noun:

- For Individual (شخصي); that has two rules:
 - i. The conceptual rule, that is to intend a specific individual
 - ii. The verbal rule, based on which:
 - a) it is correct for a 'status' (حال) to follow it
 - b) it is '*ghair munsarif*' when there is another cause as well
 - c) it does not take 'ال' or ...
- for a genus (جنسي); that has the verbal rules of the individual proper noun

The genus proper noun, has the verbal rulings of the individual proper noun, such as in 'هذا أسامة مقبلاً' in which 'أسامة' is '*ghair munsarif*', it is followed by 'status' (حال) and it does not take 'ال'.
