The Times of the Prayers

The **specific time** of the *zuhr* **prayer** extends from the moment the sun crosses the meridian up to the time required to perform it and the specific time for the '*asr* **prayer** is the time required to perform it (four *rak'ahs*) just before the sunset. The time in between is the **common time** for the two *salats*.

The **specific time** for the *maghrib* **prayer** extends from sunset until the time to required to perform it (three *rak'ahs*). The specific period of the *'isha* **prayer** is the time required to perform it before midnight. The time between these two specific times is the **common time**.

The time for the *fajr* **prayer** begins with the **second** *fajr* (widely spread brightness of the daybreak in the horizon) and lasts **until sunrise**.

Points:

The *zawal* (the inclination of the sun away from the center of the sky) is known
when the shadows start extending after getting short.

4 *Maghrib* (sunset) is known by the **disappearance of the disc** of the sun. However, **the most famous opinion** is that *maghrib* is **when the redness disappears from the eastern horizon**.
