The Clothing for Salat

- 5. It is not permissible to perform salat in a usurped dress.
- 6. It is not permissible to perform *salat* while **wearing something that covers the outside (back) of the foot**, such as *shamshak*. However, *salat* is valid with that which has leg (*saq*) such as socks. It is *mustahabb* to pray with Arab sandal.
- 9 1 m a 7. Salat is valid in all the other (than silk ...) materials under the condition of a distribution of a distribu
 - It is permissible for a man to pray in one dress; while for the woman, it is only permissible in two dresses: a *dir'* (coat of mail) and *khimar* (veil), covering all parts of her body, except the face, back of her hands, and outside of her feet, with a disagreement in regard to the feet.
 - It is permissible but *makruh* for the man to pray naked, provided that **he covers his frontal and rear private parts**. In case he has no dress, he can

 cover the private parts with anything available, even with leaves.
 - If nothing is found to cover the private parts, he can pray naked standing up, if feeling safe from being seen by anyone. If no safety is felt, he can pray



while sitting. In both the cases, he has to **do the** *ruku* ' and *sujud* by mere pointing.
