Etiquettes of *Salat al-Jumu'ah*

- *Ghusl* (ritual bath)
- Twenty *rak'ahs* of supererogatory prayers
- Early presence in the masjid
- Shaving the head, clipping the nails and trimming the mustache in advance
- Being of sobriety of demeanor (*sakinah*) and somberness (*waqar*), perfumed and wearing his best clothes
- It is *mustahabb* for the imam
 - wear a turban
 - wear a Yemeni bard (garment)
 - recline on something
 - greet the worshippers
 - sit before the sermon

✚ If the imam starts reciting a surah other than ***al-Jumu'ah*** in the first *rak'ah*, he'd better change it to that and so is true about ***al-Munafequn*** in the second

rak'ah, unless he has recited more than half of a surah and except in *al-Jahd* or *al-Tawhid*.

✚ For the person who offers the *zuhr* prayer on Friday, it is *mustahabb* to **recite the surahs audibly**.



- ✚ If the imam is someone who cannot be followed in prayer (for being a non-Shia or a sinner), the person can pray ahead of him. And it is preferable for him to offer the first two *rak'ahs* with the imam.

Section Two: The *Eid* Prayers

The prayer of the two *eids* (*Fitr* and *Adha*) is **wajib** when the (infallible) Imam is present and the same conditions for the *Jumu'ah* prayer are met. If the conditions are not met, the *wujub* will drop and it would be *mustahabb*, singly or congregationally.
