Purification with Water

- 4 The flowing water does not get *najis* unless through *najasah* prevailing one of its qualities (taste, smell, color).
- The **flowing water** is that one which does not become *najis* unless through *najasah* affecting one of its qualities. It can be purified by letting abundant water (ma' kathir) on it- in an outpouring mannertill its change is removed. The same rule is applicable to **bath water if it** has a substance (connected source).
 - 4 If the Jaari (flowing) water gets najis (by taste, color or smell) and then meets pure water that changes it or it gets changed by itself and becomes *mutlaq* water again, it can be a purifier.
- **Kurr** is such a water in a container which each of its **length, width and depth equals three and a half span.** (In the metrical system, it is a cube
- whose each side is (about) 72.5 cm which is nearly 375 cm and 375 S and in a transfer of the second state of the second sta **kilograms/liters** totally)
 - **↓** If mahqun water is **less than kurr** (qaleel), it **gets najis when najasah touches** it and gets pure by pouring *kurr* water on it at once.



- ♣ If mahqun water is kurr or more, it does not become najis unless one of its three attributes changes.
- ♣ If the kurr gets najis, it gets purified by adding kurr water to it once or more until the change is removed and it never gets purified thorough
- Im a m removal of change by itself or by blowing wind or adding pure substances q t v
 in it.
 - ♣ Kurr is equal to 1200 Iraqi ritl or that which each of its length, width and depth equals three and a half shibr (span). (In the metrical system: a cube whose each side is (about) 72.5 cm which is nearly 375 cm and 375 kg totally)
 - ♣ There is a consensus among Muslims that well water becomes najis by change in its attributes by najasah.
 - ♣ Does well water get *najis* by mere contact with *najasah* or it depends on change in its attributes? Apparently, it does become *najis* by contact.
 - ♣ The najis water of well can be purified by draining it off totally, if an intoxicant or beer or semen or one of the three bloods falls in it or when a camel dies in it (according to the majority).
 - ♣ If containing all its water is infeasible, four people should embark on draining it off, two each time, day and night.
