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Definition of *Mudhaf* water

- ♣ The mudhaf water is the water extracted from a substance or that which was pure initially before something was added to it that changed its character and it is no longer called water.
- The *mudhaf* water is pure but not a purifier of neither *hadath* (can't be used for *wudu'*, *ghusl* or *tayammum*) according to the consensus of all schools- nor *khabath* (can't remove *najasah*) –more prominently.
 - **When** *mudhaf* water meets *najasah*, it becomes *najis*, little it be or plentiful and, in this case, it cannot be used for cooking or drinking.
- If the *mudhaf* gets mixed with *mutlaq* water until it is called water, then it

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 - ♣ Purification with the water in utensils heated by the sun and also with a water heated on fire for washing the dead is disliked.



♣ The (qaleel) water used for removing the khabath becomes najis, irrespective of whether it has undergone any change on contact with impurity or not, except the water of istinja', which is pure unless undergoing change affected by najasah or coming into contact with
