#### الخبر والإنشاء

#### Complete and Incomplete Expression (المركب التام والمركب الناقص)

If the expression (لفظ) is complete, the meaning is sufficiently conveyed and the listener does not expect the speaker to complete the statement, then the expression is called "تامة" (complete); otherwise, it is "ناقص".

Example of "تامة":

"الصبرُ شجاعة" » "patience is bravery."

#### الخبر والإنشاء

The complete expression (المركب التام) is divided into:

#### 1. Predicative "خبر"

A complete compound (المركب التام) statement for which it is proper to judge it as true or false (because it has a reality and the statement is revealing that).  
Such as: "Patience is bravery."

#### 2. Non-Predicative "إنشاء"

A "المركب التام" in which the relation in the statement has no existing reality beyond the sentence

Such as: "Sit down."

The "خبر" is the only type which matters for a logician because it is a kind of "تصديق" and is capable of being true or false.
