### Substitutive *I'rab* Signs in Dual Nouns

Words that get substitutive *i'rab* signs:

1. The-six-nouns (الاسماء الستة) which get 'واى' for *raf*, *nasb* and *jarr*.
2. Dual nouns (مثنى) which get 'ا' for *raf* and 'ي' for *nasb* and *jarr*

'مثنى' is a word that signifies two of the same (things) by adding some letters to its end which are removable. Therefore, 'شفع' (couple), 'اثنان' (two) and 'قمران' are not *muthanna* because the first does not have those additional letters; the 'ان' are not removable from the second and 'قمران' refers to the sun and the moon, not two moons.
