ImamSadiq.tv **Substitutive *I'rab* in 'Ghair Munsarif'** ImamSadiq.tv

Words like 'أولات' (which does not have the letters of its singular) or 'أذرعَات' (which is a proper noun) are attached to the regular feminine plural in taking *kasra* in the state of *nasb*.

The cases in which, a haraka (not a letter) substitutes the main *i'rab* sign:

- Regular feminine plural in the state of *nasb*

ImamSadiq.tv *Nasb* → '◌ِ' example: 'رَأَيْتُ الْمُسْلِمَاتِ' ImamSadiq.tv

- 'Ghair Munsarif' in the state of *jarr*

Jarr → '◌ِ' example: 'مَرَرْتُ بِأَحْمَدَ'

وَجُرَّ بِالْفَتْحَةِ مَا لَا يَنْصَرِفُ

مَا لَمْ يُضَفَّ أَوْ يَكُ بَعْدَ "أَل" رِدْفٍ

Give *kasra* to the 'ghair munsarif' in the state of *nasb*
as long as it is not added or has not come with 'أل'
