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Phrasal 'خبر'

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If the 'خبر' is a phrase as an adverb or an adverbial (جار و مجرور), it belongs to a verb or a derivative noun; as in "دخلتُ في الدار".

Sometimes the verb or the derivative to which this type of 'خبر' belongs has to be omitted, as in 'زيدٌ (كائنٌ/يكونُ) في الدار'. These verbs are called 'افعال العموم' and the derivative nouns are derived from them.

If the phrase is 'الظرف المستقر' i.e., it belongs to the 'افعال العموم', it must be omitted and this happens when it is:

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• 'زيدٌ في الدار'؛ as in 'خبر'

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- 'مررت برجلٍ عندك'؛ as in 'صفة'
- 'مررت بزيدٍ عندك'؛ as in 'حال'
- 'جاء الذي عندك'؛ as in 'صلة'
